Submitting your abstract

2. Complete the following information:
 - Identify the conference stream
 - Name of presenter(s), title
 - Biography of each presenter (50 words)
 - Presentation outline to be included in the conference program (50 words)
3. Abstract Paper: Please identify:
 - Title of abstract
 - Purpose of presentation
 - Educational objectives
 - Summary of content
 - Presentation methods (include audio visual equipment required and room set-up preference)





Presenter(s) may submit multiple abstracts for the conference.
All submissions will be evaluated using the following criteria:

- Relevance to the conference theme
- Clarity and cohesiveness of submission
- Contribution to the knowledge and practice of ACTT
- Evidence that submission will encourage interaction among conference participants
- Consistency with the values of the OAA

Acceptance as Presenter

Please note:

1. Presenters must register and pay for the full 3 day conference. Honoraria and travel reimbursement is not available
2. An electronic version of the presentation must be submitted the Event Coordinator shortly before the conference for posting to the OAA website
3. Presenters are responsible for providing written material to the conference participants
4. Presenters will be provided with a designated time to present by the conference committee
